Second Provisional Admission List (2025-26)

The following students have been short-listed for interview for the purpose of admission to the Jubilee Hall for the session 2025-26. They are required to appear for the interview on Wednesday, the 01st October 2025 from 10:30 a.m. onwards in the Conference Room of the Hall. The students are required to get their certificates verified in the Hall Office from 9:30 a.m. onwards on Tuesday, the 30th September 2025. The selected students for admission must produce the following documents at the time of verification failing which the students so selected will forfeit their right of admission.

1. Copy of hostel application form/additional information form filled by the applicant.
2. Copy of registration fee paid for hostel application.
3. Latest Bonafide Certificate from Dean/HOD/Director or PIC.
4. Fee receipt from the department or faculty as a proof of having been admitted there.
5. Character certificate from the Head of Department/Institute last attended. In case of Ph.D. students, character certificate from the respective Head of the Department will be entertained.
6. Date of birth certificate/10th Class Certificate.
7. Copy of CUET/relevant score card on the basis of which the student has been admitted to the department, wherever applicable.
8. The marks sheet of last examination in original along with attested copies of the same.
9. UGC-NET/CSIR Certificate.
10. No dues and Conduct certificate from the previous hostel, wherever applicable.
11. Domicile certificate (must not be more than 1 year old) OR father's Job ID in case father of applicant is employed with Central/State Government.
12. Copies of Voter IDs and Aadhar Cards (after severing Aadhar numbers) of applicant and his parents.
13. Copy of Passport and Visa in case of Foreign Students.

The list is provisional and in no way guarantees admission to the Hall. Ranking in this list is subject to change in the light of departmental merit lists and corrections, if any.

The Claims, if any, against the ranking in the list can be submitted in the Hall Office till Monday, the 29th September 2025 by 1:00 p.m. In case of the claims of the candidates are found valid they will be informed through a notice displayed on the notice board of Jubilee Hall on Monday, the 29th September 2025 by 4:00 p.m. In this connection the decision of the Admission Committee will be final. The admissions of Ph.D. candidates will be subject to the production of BRS letter, joining and fee receipt.
